Our Curriculum

Autumn Term

This autumn our topic will be Toys. In this topic we will look at comparing old and new toys.

Thinking about what toys we would play with compared to the toys our grown up would when they were children. In science, we will look at what materials toys are made out of and why.

We will then use the material knowledge we have learnt to design and make our own toy box in DT. In computing we will use Beebots to begin to learn about coding and algorithms.

In English we will be looking at a range of texts linked to toys. We will look at recounts, stories, instructions and letter writing. We will continue with our Phonic lessons to help with our reading and writing. In Maths we will be looking at numbers to 100 and finding one more and less than a number. We will also begin to learn our number bonds, these will help us with simple addition and subtraction problems.

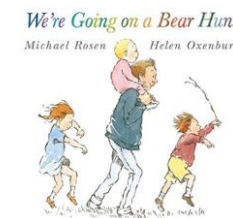
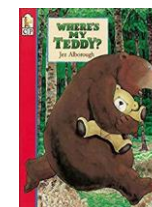


In the park

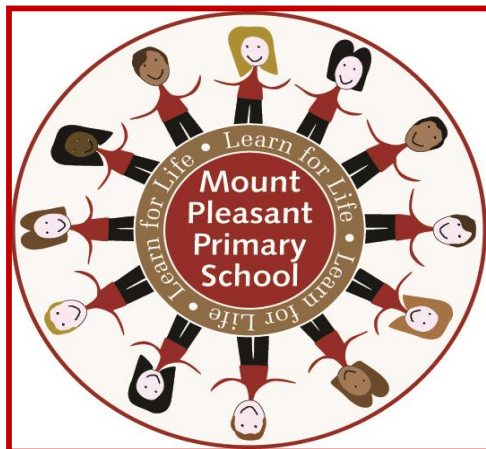


Homework
