

## Maths


Recognise and order numbers to 10 then 20

## Literacy:

Hear and recognise when words rhyme or begin with the same sounds (alliteration). Also begin to offer other words that rhyme or begin with the same sound  
Begin to say the sounds (phonemes) that are in simple words e.g. c-a-t (oral segmenting) and be able to put the sounds together to hear what words are (oral blending)  
Write their first name and surname from memory and form the letters correctly


