Compare and describe weight/height/length

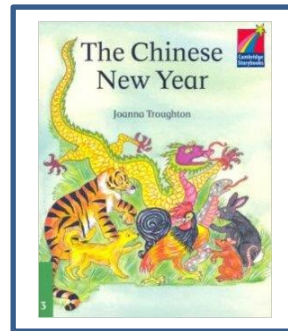
